### PART II

## NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the period covered by this report, the 7th Motor Transport Battalion prepared for embarkation aboard USN vessels for the return to CONUS and, after preparations had been completed, embarked aboard the USS Tulare, USS Anchorage, and the USS Alamo for the actual voyage, arriving CONUS approximately three weeks later.

From the first of February until the actual embarkation aboard the vessels began, 7th Motor Transport Battalion was based at the FLC "stand-down" area in DaNang, RVN. The time was utilized in the preparation of personnel and equipment for the voyage. On the 12th of February an advance party from "B" Company departed DaNang aboard the USS Tulare, arriving at Camp Pendleton, the future home of the Battalion, on 1 March. The remainder of "B" Company was placed in a cadre status.

On the 19th of February the Battalion Headquarters, "A" Company (Rein), and Headquarters and Service Company (-) and one platoon from the 3rd Bridge Company embarked aboard the USS Anchorage (LSD-36), departing at 2000 the same day. Transport Company and "C" Company embarked aboard the USS Alamo and also departed DaNang on the 19th of February.

During the 21 day voyage the Battalion conducted inspections, held classes on shipboard life and other subjects, and conducted normal maintenance on the vehicles. The voyage was interrupted by a refueling stop at Subic Bay, Phillipine Islands. The USS Anchorage arrived at Camp Pendleton; California, on 12 March, docking at Camp Del Mar. The USS Alamo arrived on the 13th of March, also docking at Camp Del Mar.



I. The GO of Treeps set with TF 76 representatives as 17 February 1970 and reserved word that the ships would be ready for loading the noming of the 19th of February. All vehicles from the Battalion, Bridge Company, and retrograde vehicles, and COMBRES were staged and ready to be loaded as soon as the ships were tied up at the plan. A ships platons, emsisting of one officer and ho enlisted, went abourd as soon as the ships arrived at the plan.

2. The unbarkation abourd ship of all troops and equipment communed at 1030 19 February 1970 and was completed by 2000 19 February 1970. Personnel subarked completed of the followings

In The embarked troops equalsted of Bettelion Headgesrters, "A" Go. (Rein), MAS Go. (-), and one plateen from Bridge Company. Control of troops was handled by the Company Commanders under the direction of the CO of Troops. Afficers were nesigned dubles including Security Afficer, Ness Officer, Laundry Officer, and OEC Brigg Plateen. In interior guard was established for negarity and fire watch.

- 4. The following is a chromology of the events by date:
  - 19 Peb 1970 USS Anchorage (LED-36) departed Danang at 2000, destination Camp Del Mar.
  - 20 Feb 1970 The skip departed the tax exclusion some (120 miles sut) at shout 6500 20 Feb 1970. Each Company held fermations on the flight deak and conducted personnel and weepons importions.
  - 21 Feb 1970 Ship arrived at Sahic Bay, Phillipine Islands at 1530 for a partial stop. It was determined by the Havy that the ship would sail at 1600 on 2h Feb 1970.
  - 22 Feb 1970 Holiday remains; base liberty declared for all embersed troops.
  - 23 Feb 1970 moliday restine; base liberty declared for all embarked transp.
  - 2h Feb 1970 Reguel work day; a personnel inspection was conducted on all emberted troops. The ship departed Schio Bay at 1600 2h Feb 1970.
  - 25 Feb 1970 . Each company conducted one hour physical fitness training.

- 27 Peb 1970 Preparation for Battalian CO Personnel Inspection.
- 28 Feb 1970 All vehicles were shocked for security and to incure they were properly tied down. Afternoon; Haliday Routine.
- 2 Mar 1970 Holiday Boutine; Church Call. An Episcopal Chaplain conducted services and a Onthelia Lay Lunder held services for all Roman Catholics.
- 2 Mar 1978 Inspection of vehicles for the down and security. Battalian CO's Personnel Inspection of all emberked traops.
- 3 Mar 1970 A class given by the Navy on Shipboard protocal, also companies conducted rifle inspections.
- h Har 1970 Tours of the ship for designated personnel. A class was given to all troops on Veteran's Benefits.
- 5 Mer 1970 Due to exceeding the International Date Line 5 Merch occurred twice. On the first 5 Merch all vehicles were checked for proper tie down and security and all vehicles were started. A class on Navy traditions was conducted, The 2nd 5 Merch Physical Fitness was conducted.
- E6 Thr 1970 Tour of the skip for designated personnel. A Class on Customs and Traditions of the Harine Corps was conducted.
  - 7 Mer 1970 Preparation for Battalion CO's Rifle and Personnel Inspection.
    In the afternoon the ship declared Holiday Routine.
- 8 Nor 1970 Church Onli, the Embarked Chaplain held services for those personnel of the Episcopal Faith. Lay Lenders conducted corridor for personnel of other faiths.
- 9 Nor 1970 Battalian Commander held a Personnel and Rifle Inspection of 7th Hoter Transport Ba.
- 10 Mar 1970 A class was conducted on Career Planning and also the Havy gave a class on Naval Heroes.
- 11 May 1970 Tour of ship for designated personnel. A class was given in Separations and Travel.
- 12 Har 1970 Arrived at Gasp Del Her and disembarked.
